## Memo

Bismillahirrahmaanirrahiim Assalamu'alaikum wr wb

Jamaah Masjid Al Hijrah and CIDE Academy honored by Allah Subhanahu Wata'ala, Alhamdulillah, we are grateful to Allah who has given us all health favors.

In accordance with the announcement of the Australian NSW government dated May 6, 2021 regarding the update on the restrictions of COVID-19 pandemic from NSW Premier and the Minister for Health and Medical Research, CIDE NSW will follow the regulations for places of worship. Regarding the Ramadan 1442H Program at the Al Hijrah Mosque and at the CIDE Academy which is currently running, there are changes to the schedule as follows:

1. **Masks are mandatory when entering the mosque**
2. Isya and Taraweeh prayers are still carried out with the following schedule:
  - a. 7:15 pm - 7:20 pm Isha prayer
  - b. 7:20 pm - 7:30 pm Taraweeh preparation
  - c. 7:30 pm - 8:00 pm Taraweeh and Witr Prayers
3. There is no Kultum after Isha prayer at Masjid Al Hijrah
4. There is no Al-Quran recitations on both facilities
5. The Kajian Ramadan after Witr will be held online at 8:30 pm
6. **I'tikaf program will be cancelled until Monday, 10 May 2021** pending further developments
7. The Quran Competition on Saturday, 8 May 2021 will be postponed until further developments
8. There is no Iftar Jama'i and Youth Talk at Masjid Al Hijrah for Saturday, 8 May 2021
9. TPA CIDE Academy on 9 May 2021, will be held online and will be off on 16 May 2021
10. According to the schedule, the TPA Al Hijrah will be off from 8 May 2021 to 22 May 2021
11. Friday prayer is still held with one session starting at 1:15 pm and is mandatory to wear a mask
12. Jamaah are strongly encouraged to bring their own prayer mats.
13. The recording of names and contact numbers will still be carried out for tracking purposes and it is advisable to carry out the NSW Service app COVID Safe QR Checkin - Checkout.
14. Health protocols will continue to be enforced by providing places for hand hygiene.
15. We will announce the plan for the implementation of Eid Al-Fitr prayer on Monday 10 May 2021

We hope that all the jamaah will be able to understand the situation and hopefully the jamaah will remain in good health.

The NSW CIDE Executive continues to observe developments and establish intensive communication with parties related to the COVID-19 pandemic as well as the NSW CIDE Board of Imam to discuss the next steps to adjust the changes in policy of the NSW Government
